



The 15th Kiwassee Kiwanis Roger Briggs Golf Scramble is Monday, July 26, 2021, at Snow Snake Ski and Golf Resort, 3407 E. Mannsiding Rd, Harrison, MI. COVID forced us to cancel the 2020 outing and we anticipate a large group to gather this year for the four-person scramble that includes 18 holes of golf with a cart, Continental breakfast, lunch at the turn, and an awards banquet.

The scramble is named for longtime Kiwassee Kiwanis member Roger Briggs, who died September 14, 2020. Thirty years of service to the club and our community included his chairing Kiwassee's golf scramble for several years. An avid golfer himself, he opened and operated Pro Golf Midland for eleven years before retiring in 2010.

This event is one of three annual fundraisers for our club. Monies raised support organizations and initiatives that address the emotional, physical and cognitive needs of children, youth, and adults, including the Salvation Army, Midland County Emergency Food Pantry; West and North Midland Family Centers; The ROCK Center for Youth Development; and the Children's Grief Center. Kiwassee also initiated the Midland Area Chromebook Replacement Fund, which raised \$7000+ for students' laptops lost in the May, 2020, flood.
